

IBPS Clerk Reserve List 2026

CRP CSA-XV | Candidate guide for vacancies of 2026-27

What this PDF is: an ExamTune explanation of reserve-list rules, official status-checking steps and actions after allotment. It is not an IBPS-issued notice, candidate result or cutoff list.

Understand the three stages

Stage	What it means
Reserve-list inclusion	You remain eligible for possible further allotment if suitable additional vacancies are reported. Inclusion alone does not guarantee selection.
Provisional allotment	IBPS identifies a participating bank subject to recruitment conditions. Eligibility and documents still require verification.
Bank appointment	The allotted bank communicates its offer and joining requirements after completing the applicable checks.

Rules that matter

- Allotment follows Main-examination merit, State/UT and category vacancies, preferences and applicable reservation conditions. [1, 2]
- The notification permits a reserve panel of approximately 30% of category vacancies, subject to candidate availability. This is not an individual candidate's selection probability. [1]
- Further rounds depend on additional vacancies reported by banks; neither a particular round nor an allotment date is guaranteed. [1, 2]
- The stated validity is one year after provisional allotment or until a fresh provisional allotment, whichever occurs earlier. Read any later notice for the relevant cycle. [1]

Choose CSA-XV for this guide. A CSA-XVI recruitment notice or a PO/MT notice belongs to a different process.

Check your status

Use the official cycle page as your starting point.

01. Open IBPS. Go to [the official CRP CSA-XV page](#). If that page is unavailable, use [ibps.in](#) and locate the CSA-XV recruitment section.

02. Choose the relevant round. Open the reserve-list provisional-allotment notice and the candidate-status link shown for your cycle. Read the access dates on that notice.

03. Confirm the cycle before logging in. The page should identify CSA-XV. Enter the requested Registration/Roll Number, Password or Date of Birth, and security code in the format displayed.

04. Read the complete result. Check the candidate details, category/State or UT, status and allotted-bank information where shown. Do not infer allotment from a headline or a cutoff prediction.

05. Save your record. Download or print the result available to you and keep it with your application. Follow the allotted bank's next communication; a saved result does not replace its appointment instructions.

Read the status carefully

What you see	What to do next
Allotted / provisionally allotted	Read the attached conditions and monitor the named bank's official recruitment page and communication.
Not allotted / no allotment in this round	Use the actual message shown. Do not assume that the next round is certain or that every reserve candidate will receive a bank.
Login error or unavailable page	Recheck the cycle, credentials, date format and access window. Retry later if there is a server error; an error page is not a result.

Need help with the recruitment portal?

Use the [IBPS Candidate Grievance Redressal System](#). Read its FAQs, register your complaint with a valid email address, and keep the complaint number to track the response. Include the cycle, issue and an appropriate screenshot; never send your password. [3]

After provisional allotment

Prepare your records and follow the allotted bank's checklist.

Document folder to keep ready

- Submitted application printout and the result/allotment record available to you.
- Original identity and date-of-birth evidence; educational certificates and marksheets.
- Applicable category, disability or ex-servicemen documents in the prescribed formats.
- Local-language study evidence, and employer NOC or other service records where applicable.
- Photographs, copies and additional forms specifically requested by the allotted bank.

This preparation list is not exhaustive. The bank's verification instructions and the recruitment notice determine the required records. [1]

Local-language requirement

Candidates who need the Local Language Proficiency Test must qualify before joining. A Class 10 or higher marksheet/certificate evidencing study of the specified or opted local language provides the prescribed exemption, subject to verification. [1]

Three questions candidates often ask

Does a reserve list guarantee a job?

No. Extra vacancies and all applicable recruitment conditions still matter.

Does the PDF contain my result or an official cutoff?

No. Read your result and any cutoff disclosure through the official cycle-specific source.

What should I do while waiting?

Keep your contact details accessible, organise the document folder and continue preparation rather than treating a possible future round as assured.
