

IBPS RRB Clerk Cut Off 2026: Expected and Previous Year State-wise Marks

IBPS RRB Clerk Cut Off 2026 is one of the most important benchmarks for candidates preparing for the Office Assistant (Multipurpose) examination conducted under CRP RRBs XV. The cut off is not the same across India because IBPS releases the **IBPS RRB Clerk State Wise Cut Off** according to the state/UT, category, vacancies, exam difficulty and candidate performance.

As of **12 September 2026**, the official **IBPS RRB Clerk Cut Off** for the 2026 recruitment cycle has not been released because the examination is yet to be conducted. The Office Assistant Preliminary Examination is scheduled for **6, 12 and 13 December 2026**, while the Main Examination is scheduled for **30 January 2027**. Candidates can therefore use the expected ranges and previous year marks given below only for preparation and target-setting.

Important: The 2026 expected cut off ranges given on this page are analytical estimates, not official IBPS cut offs. Actual marks may be higher or lower depending on the examination difficulty, vacancies, normalization and candidate performance.

Note: Candidates should not treat an expected cut off as a guaranteed qualifying score. A safer preparation target is generally to remain several marks above the upper end of the expected range while maintaining high accuracy.

IBPS RRB Clerk Previous Year Cut Off – Prelims

The latest available **IBPS RRB Clerk Previous Year Cut Off** shows significant variation between states. In the 2025 Prelims data, Punjab recorded a General cut off of **77.50**, West Bengal **77.00** and Himachal Pradesh **75.75**. At the other end, Mizoram was **48.50**, Karnataka **58.25** and Nagaland **60.50**.

This large difference explains why candidates should always study the **RRB Clerk State Wise Cut Off** instead of relying on a single all-India number. IBPS RRB Office Assistant recruitment is linked with participating Regional Rural Banks and state-wise vacancies, making the competition pattern different across regions.

IBPS RRB Clerk Mains Cut Off – Previous Year State Wise Marks

The Main Examination carries 200 marks, but the final/provisional-allotment cut off data is commonly reported as a score out of 100. The table below gives the **2025 UR minimum scores for provisional allotment**.

How is IBPS RRB Clerk Cut Off Decided?

The **IBPS RRB Clerk Cut Off Marks** are not fixed in advance. They are influenced by several factors, including the number of vacancies reported by participating RRBs, number of candidates appearing from a state, difficulty level of the question paper, category-wise competition and normalization of scores where applicable.

A relatively easy paper can push the **RRB Clerk Prelims Cut Off** upward because more candidates may achieve higher scores. A difficult examination or a different vacancy-to-candidate ratio can reduce it. This is why comparing only one previous year is not sufficient.

IBPS RRB Clerk Prelims Cut Off and Exam Pattern

The Office Assistant Prelims examination consists of **80 questions for 80 marks**. Reasoning contains 40 questions for 40 marks with 25 minutes, while Numerical Ability contains 40 questions for 40 marks with 20 minutes. The total duration is **45 minutes**.

Prelims is a screening stage. Candidates shortlisted through the **RRB Clerk Prelims Cut Off** become eligible for the Main Examination. For Office Assistant recruitment, there is no interview; therefore, performance in the Main Examination is particularly important for final selection.

What is a Safe Score for IBPS RRB Clerk?

There is no single safe score applicable to every state. Candidates from states with historically high **IBPS RRB Clerk State Wise Cut Off** should aim significantly above the recent cut off. For example, states such as Punjab, West Bengal and Himachal Pradesh have recently recorded comparatively high Prelims marks, whereas other states have shown lower cut offs.

Instead of preparing exactly for the expected cut off, candidates should target maximum correct attempts with strong accuracy. Because negative marking applies to incorrect answers, attempting more questions without accuracy may reduce the final score.

IBPS RRB Clerk Previous Year Cut Off Trend

The **IBPS RRB Clerk Previous Year Cut Off** trend confirms that state-wise marks can change noticeably from one recruitment cycle to another. A state's previous cut off is useful as a benchmark, but it cannot guarantee the next cut off. Candidates should analyse at least the latest two or three examination cycles, state vacancies and paper difficulty before fixing their target score.

ExamTune Analysis: For preparation, use previous year marks as the minimum benchmark rather than the final target. A candidate consistently scoring above the recent state cut off in full-length mocks is in a stronger position, but the official result will depend entirely on the cut off released by IBPS.

IBPS RRB Clerk Cut Off 2026 – Key Takeaway

The official **IBPS RRB Clerk Cut Off 2026** will be known only after IBPS conducts the examination and releases the relevant result/scorecard. Until then, candidates should use the **RRB Clerk Expected Cut Off** only as a preparation reference. The latest previous year state-wise marks show that the cut off can vary substantially across states, making state-specific preparation analysis essential.
