

IBPS RRB Clerk Vacancy 2026: State-wise and Category-wise Vacancies

Office Assistant (Multipurpose) - CRP RRBs-XV

IBPS RRB Clerk Vacancy 2026 details have been updated by the Institute of Banking Personnel Selection (IBPS) for the recruitment of Office Assistants (Multipurpose) under CRP RRBs-XV. According to the latest vacancy position updated on **9 September 2026**, a total of **8,222 Office Assistant vacancies** are available across participating Regional Rural Banks (RRBs). Candidates preparing for the RRB Clerk examination should carefully check the state-wise and category-wise vacancy distribution because recruitment and allotment for this post are linked to the state and participating RRB selected during the application process.

The original CRP RRBs-XV notification had reported **8,183 IBPS RRB Clerk vacancies**. IBPS later updated the vacancy annexure, and **39 Office Assistant vacancies for Tripura** were added, taking the overall number to **8,222 vacancies**. The official designation of the post commonly known as IBPS RRB Clerk is **Office Assistant (Multipurpose)**.

Latest Update: IBPS updated the CRP RRBs-XV vacancy position on 9 September 2026. The total Office Assistant (Multipurpose) vacancy is now **8,222**. These vacancies are indicative and may change depending on the actual requirements reported by participating Regional Rural Banks.

IBPS RRB Clerk Vacancy 2026 Overview

The **IBPS RRB Clerk Vacancy** has been announced separately for different states and reservation categories. Uttar Pradesh has the highest number of Office Assistant posts in the latest vacancy list, followed by Andhra Pradesh and Telangana. IBPS RRB Clerk Category-wise Vacancy 2026

The **IBPS RRB Office Assistant vacancy** is divided among General, OBC (NCL), SC, ST and EWS categories according to the reservation rules applicable to participating RRBs. General category candidates have the largest share with **3,470 vacancies**, followed by OBC (NCL) candidates with **1,914 vacancies**.

Which State Has the Highest IBPS RRB Clerk Vacancy?

According to the latest **RRB Clerk vacancy list**, **Uttar Pradesh has the highest number of vacancies with 1,200 posts**. Andhra Pradesh is second with **900 vacancies**, while Telangana has **750 vacancies**. Odisha has 600 posts, Gujarat has 510 posts and Bihar has 500 posts.

The number of vacancies differs significantly from one state to another because participating Regional Rural Banks report their manpower requirements independently. Candidates should therefore evaluate the **IBPS RRB Clerk state vacancy** for the state they intend to apply for rather than relying only on the overall national vacancy number.

IBPS RRB Clerk Vacancy Increased from 8,183 to 8,222

One of the most important changes candidates should note is the revision in the **IBPS RRB Clerk total vacancy**. At the time of the original notification, IBPS reported **8,183 Office Assistant vacancies**, while Tripura's figures had not been reported. In the updated vacancy annexure dated 9 September 2026, **Tripura Gramin Bank reported 39 vacancies**.

Tripura's updated distribution includes **6 SC, 12 ST, 0 OBC (NCL), 3 EWS and 18 General vacancies**. After the addition of these 39 posts, the overall **IBPS RRB Office Assistant vacancy** increased to **8,222**.

Are IBPS RRB Clerk Vacancies Final?

No. Candidates must understand that the published **IBPS RRB Clerk vacancies** are described by IBPS as **indicative and anticipated vacancies** communicated by participating Regional Rural Banks. The vacancy position may increase or decrease depending on the actual manpower requirements subsequently reported by the RRBs.

Provisional allotment is ultimately carried out on the basis of the actual vacancies reported by participating banks and other applicable conditions. Therefore, candidates should continue checking official IBPS recruitment updates even after submitting their application.

Important: Do not confuse the Office Assistant vacancy with Officer Scale-I, Scale-II or Scale-III vacancies. The **8,222 vacancies discussed on this page are specifically for IBPS RRB Office Assistant (Multipurpose), commonly called RRB Clerk.**

Why IBPS RRB Clerk State-wise Vacancy Matters

The **IBPS RRB Clerk state wise vacancy** is important because Office Assistant recruitment is closely connected with the participating RRB and the state for which a candidate applies. Apart from checking vacancy numbers, candidates should also carefully review the prescribed local-language requirement and other eligibility conditions before selecting a state.

A state with a larger number of vacancies may provide more recruitment opportunities, but vacancy count alone should not be treated as a prediction of the cut off. The **IBPS RRB Clerk cut off** can also be affected by the number of applicants, difficulty level of the examination, candidate performance, reservation category and other recruitment factors.
