

IBPS RRB PO Admit Card 2026 for the Officer Scale-I Preliminary Examination has **not been released yet** as of 15 September 2026. The Institute of Banking Personnel Selection (IBPS) is currently accepting applications for CRP RRBs-XV, and the online registration window remains open until **21 September 2026**. Candidates who successfully submit their applications will be able to download the **IBPS RRB PO Call Letter** from the official IBPS website once the link is activated.

According to the official IBPS examination calendar, the **IBPS RRB PO Prelims Exam 2026** for Officer Scale-I is scheduled for **21 and 22 November 2026**, while the Officer Scale-I Main Examination is scheduled for **20 December 2026**. The individual exam date, examination centre, reporting time, gate-closing time and **IBPS RRB PO Shift Timing** will be confirmed through the candidate's call letter.

Latest Update – 15 September 2026:

The IBPS RRB Officer Scale-I Prelims Admit Card has not been released. Candidates should not confuse unofficial or previous-year shift schedules with the final 2026 schedule. Exact shift and reporting time will be printed on each candidate's call letter.

IBPS RRB PO Admit Card 2026 Download Link

The **IBPS RRB PO Admit Card Download Link** will be activated by IBPS for candidates registered for Officer Scale-I under CRP RRBs-XV. As of 15 September 2026, the Preliminary Examination call-letter link is **not active**.

The button should be updated with the official IBPS call-letter link after release.

Candidates are advised to rely only on the official IBPS recruitment page for the **RRB Officer Scale I Call Letter**. Do not enter your registration credentials on unknown or unofficial websites.

When Will IBPS RRB PO Admit Card 2026 Be Released?

IBPS has not announced a specific date for release of the **IBPS RRB PO Prelims Admit Card**. The official recruitment schedule places the preliminary call-letter activity in the period before the November examination. Therefore, candidates should wait for an official IBPS update instead of relying on an unconfirmed date circulated on social media or coaching websites.

Once released, the **IBPS RRB Officer Scale I Admit Card** will contain candidate-specific information including the exact exam date, reporting time, examination shift and venue address.

IBPS RRB PO Exam Date 2026

The official IBPS examination calendar has announced the examination dates for CRP RRBs-XV Officer Scale-I.

Officer Scale-I Preliminary Examination	21 & 22 November 2026
Officer Scale-I Main Examination	20 December 2026

Candidates must check their individual **IBPS RRB PO Call Letter** to know which of the two Preliminary Examination dates has been allotted to them.

IBPS RRB PO Shift Timing 2026

The exact **IBPS RRB PO Shift Timing**, reporting time and gate-closing time have not been officially published for individual candidates as of 15 September 2026. Candidates should therefore avoid treating previous-year shift schedules or unofficial timing tables as confirmed 2026 timings.

Accuracy Note: The final shift, reporting time and entry instructions printed on the candidate's admit card should always be treated as authoritative.

How to Download IBPS RRB PO Admit Card 2026

1. Visit the official Institute of Banking Personnel Selection website.
2. Open the section for **CRP Regional Rural Banks**.
3. Select **Regional Rural Banks XV / CRP RRBs-XV**.
4. Open the link for the **Officer Scale-I Preliminary Examination Call Letter**.
5. Enter the required login credentials shown on the portal.
6. Complete the security/captcha verification.
7. Click on the login or submit button.
8. Check all details mentioned on the **IBPS RRB PO Hall Ticket**.
9. Download the call letter and take a clear printout for examination day.

Details Mentioned on IBPS RRB PO Call Letter

After completing the **IBPS RRB PO Admit Card Download**, candidates should carefully verify the information printed on the document. It is expected to contain examination and candidate-specific details such as:

- Candidate's name
- Registration number
- Roll number
- Candidate photograph
- Examination date
- Reporting time
- Examination shift

- Exam centre name
- Complete examination venue/address
- Important examination-day instructions
- Documents required at the examination centre

If there is any material discrepancy in the call letter, candidates should use the official IBPS grievance/contact mechanism before the examination.

IBPS RRB PO Exam-Day Documents

Candidates should carefully prepare the required **IBPS RRB PO Exam Day Documents**. Based on the examination and identity-verification requirements, the key documents include:

Document	Requirement
IBPS RRB PO Call Letter	Printed valid examination call letter with required photograph
Original Photo ID	Currently valid original photo identity proof bearing the same name as the call letter
Photo ID Photocopy	Carry a photocopy of the same valid photo ID
Additional Photograph	One additional photograph, same as the photograph pasted/used on the call letter
Scribe Form	Required where applicable as per IBPS rules

Valid Photo Identity Proofs

The notification allows prescribed currently valid photo identity documents. These include, as applicable:

- PAN Card
- Passport
- Permanent Driving Licence
- Voter ID Card with photograph
- Bank Passbook with photograph
- Aadhaar Card or E-Aadhaar with photograph
- Employee ID
- Identity Card issued by a recognised college or university
- Bar Council Identity Card with photograph
- Permitted photo identity proof issued on official letterhead by the prescribed authority

Not Accepted: Ration Card and Learner's Driving Licence are not accepted as valid identity proof for this selection process.

Name on ID Proof Must Match

The name on the photo identity proof should match the name appearing on the call letter/application.

Candidates who have legally changed their name should keep the prescribed supporting original documents,

such as the applicable Gazette notification, marriage certificate or affidavit, as required under IBPS instructions.

Keep the Prelims Call Letter Safe for the Main Exam

This is particularly important for Officer Scale-I candidates. During the Preliminary Examination, the call letter and photocopy of the photo ID may be authenticated/stamped by examination-centre officials and returned to the candidate.

Candidates shortlisted for the Main Examination are required to preserve these authenticated Preliminary Examination documents and carry them along with the Main Examination call letter and other prescribed documents. Therefore, do **not throw away the stamped Preliminary Examination call letter** after the exam.

IBPS RRB PO Prelims Exam Pattern 2026

The Officer Scale-I Preliminary Examination consists of **80 questions for 80 marks** with an overall duration of **45 minutes**.

Quantitative Aptitude	40	40	20 minutes

IBPS RRB PO Exam-Day Instructions

- Read every instruction printed on the **IBPS RRB PO Admit Card** and information handout.
- Reach the examination venue according to the reporting time printed on your call letter.
- Carry the printed call letter and all prescribed identity-verification documents.
- Paste/attach the required photograph exactly as instructed on the call letter.
- Carry one additional photograph matching the photograph required with the call letter.
- Do not carry prohibited electronic devices or other restricted articles into the examination centre.
- Cooperate with identity, photograph, biometric or other verification procedures conducted by IBPS.
- Do not alter your appearance in a way that creates difficulty in matching you with your application photograph.
- Follow any additional instructions issued through the official information handout or individual call letter.

Items Candidates Should Avoid Carrying

IBPS examination-centre instructions restrict a range of personal and electronic items. Candidates should avoid carrying unnecessary belongings such as mobile phones, calculators, smart watches, Bluetooth devices, earphones, storage devices, bags and other prohibited articles mentioned in the official instructions.

The exact permitted and prohibited items for the Officer Scale-I Preliminary Examination should be checked again in the official information handout released with the **IBPS RRB PO Prelims Admit Card**.

What to Do If IBPS RRB PO Admit Card Does Not Download?

If the **RRB PO Admit Card Download** page is active but the candidate is unable to access the call letter:

- Check the entered registration/roll number carefully.
- Enter the login credentials in the format requested on the official page.
- Complete the captcha correctly.
- Use an updated browser and stable internet connection.
- Check the registered email/SMS records for registration information.
- Use the official IBPS grievance mechanism if the problem continues.

IBPS RRB PO Admit Card 2026 – Important Accuracy Check

Several websites may publish expected admit-card dates and previous-year **IBPS RRB PO Shift Timing** tables before IBPS officially activates the call-letter portal. Candidates should distinguish between confirmed information and estimates.

As of **15 September 2026**:

- **Officer Scale-I Prelims Date:** Confirmed as 21 and 22 November 2026.
- **Officer Scale-I Main Exam:** Scheduled for 20 December 2026.
- **Prelims Admit Card:** Not released yet.
- **Admit Card Direct Link:** Not active yet.
- **Candidate Shift:** Not allotted publicly; check individual call letter after release.
- **Reporting Time:** To be checked on individual call letter.

Frequently Asked Questions

Is IBPS RRB PO Admit Card 2026 released?

No. As of 15 September 2026, the Officer Scale-I Prelims admit card has not been released.

What is the IBPS RRB PO Prelims exam date?

The Officer Scale-I Prelims are scheduled for 21 and 22 November 2026.

What is the IBPS RRB PO Mains exam date?

The Officer Scale-I Main Examination is scheduled for 20 December 2026.

Where can I download the IBPS RRB PO Call Letter?

It will be available through the official IBPS CRP RRBs-XV section after release.

Is the IBPS RRB PO shift timing officially released?

No candidate-wise shift schedule is available yet. Check the final timing on your call letter.

What documents are required with the IBPS RRB PO Admit Card?

Carry the call letter, original valid photo ID, its photocopy and the prescribed additional photograph.

Is Aadhaar Card accepted as photo ID?

Aadhaar/E-Aadhaar with photograph is among the permitted identity proofs under the prescribed IBPS rules.

Is a Learner's Driving Licence accepted?

No. Learner's Driving Licence is not accepted as valid ID proof.

Should I keep my Prelims admit card after the exam?

Yes. Preserve the authenticated/stamped Prelims call letter and ID-proof photocopy for the Main Examination.

How long is the IBPS RRB PO Prelims exam?

The Officer Scale-I Preliminary Examination lasts 45 minutes.

Conclusion

The **IBPS RRB PO Admit Card 2026** is an essential document for candidates appearing for the Officer Scale-I Preliminary Examination under CRP RRBs-XV. As of 15 September 2026, the **IBPS RRB PO Admit Card Download Link** has not been activated. The official Preliminary Examination dates are 21 and 22 November 2026, followed by the Main Examination on 20 December 2026.

Candidates should regularly check the official IBPS recruitment page and download the **IBPS RRB PO Call Letter** as soon as it is released. Most importantly, treat the exam date, **IBPS RRB PO Reporting Time**, shift, gate-closing time, examination centre and document instructions printed on the individual call letter as final.
